Data for 2014 may vary slightly from earlier publications due to clarification of data definitions and revisions of data by facilities.

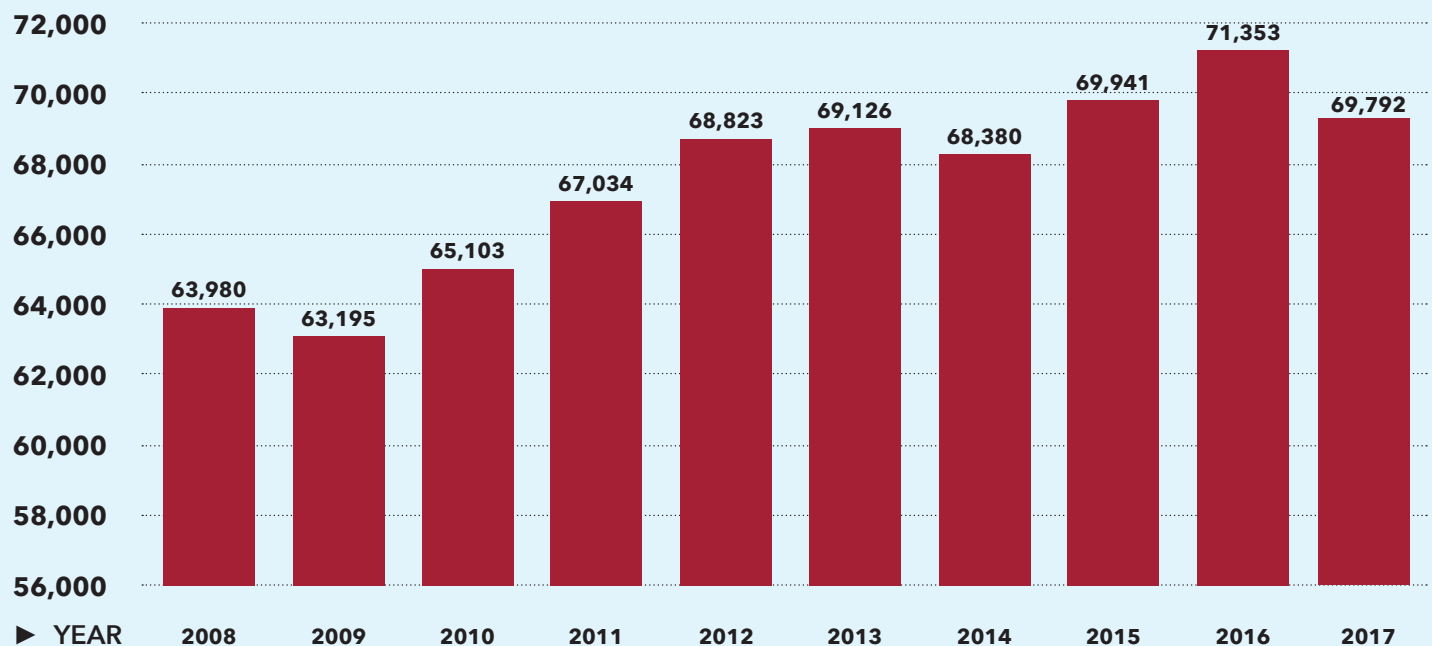

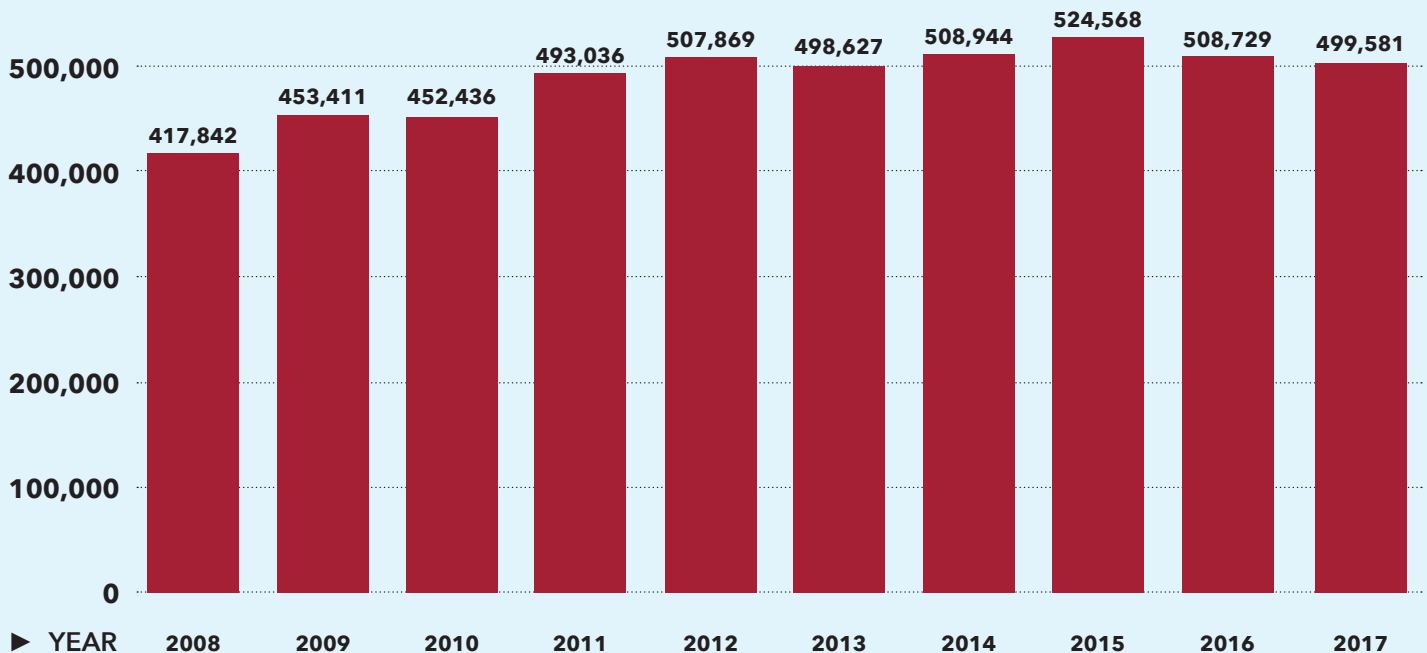

The number of inpatient admissions declined by approximately 1.7% between 2016 and 2017. This is the sixth year in a row that inpatient admissions have fallen. This trend is likely to continue as services shift to the outpatient setting rather than an inpatient one.
