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## ABOUT THIS REPORT

The charts and tables in this publication are intended to provide aggregate and comparative data on health-care facility utilization in the District of Columbia. The source of the data is the District of Columbia Hospital Association's (DCHA) Monthly Utilization Survey and Quarterly Bed Capacity and Census Survey (self-reported by individual facilities). Data for 2014 may vary slightly from earlier publications due to clarification of data definitions and revisions of data by facilities.

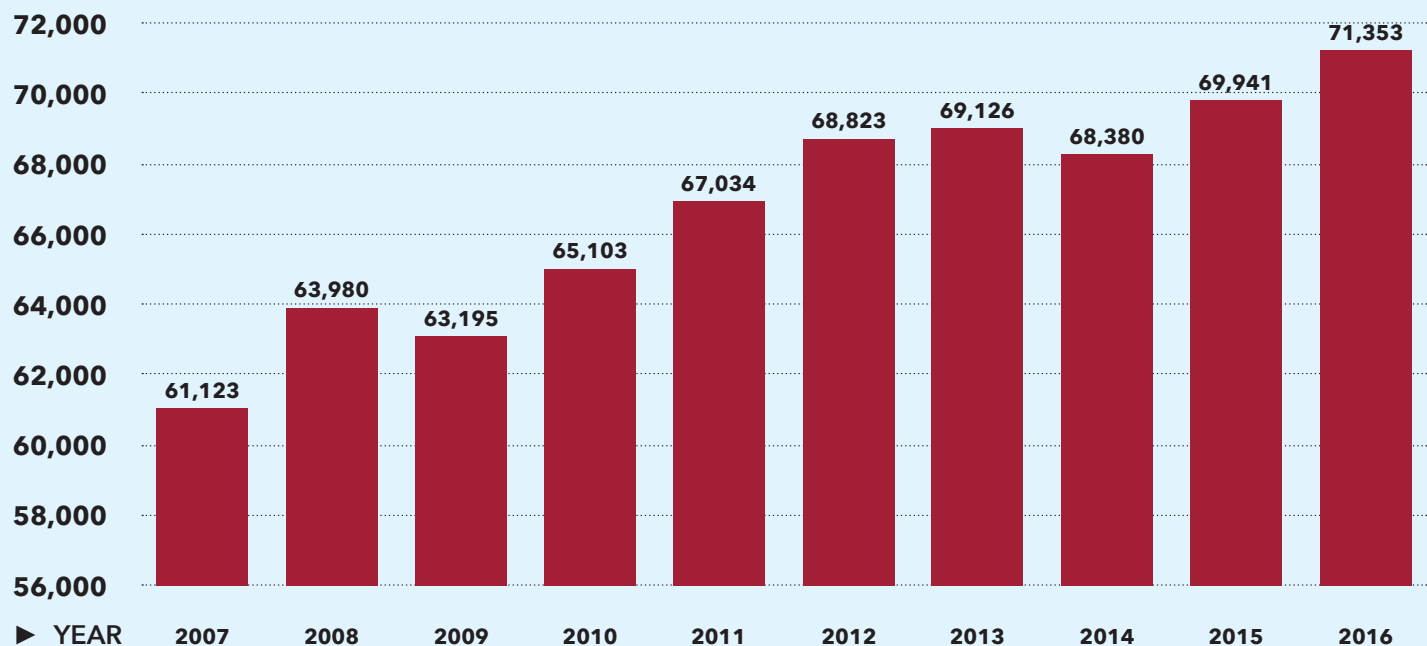

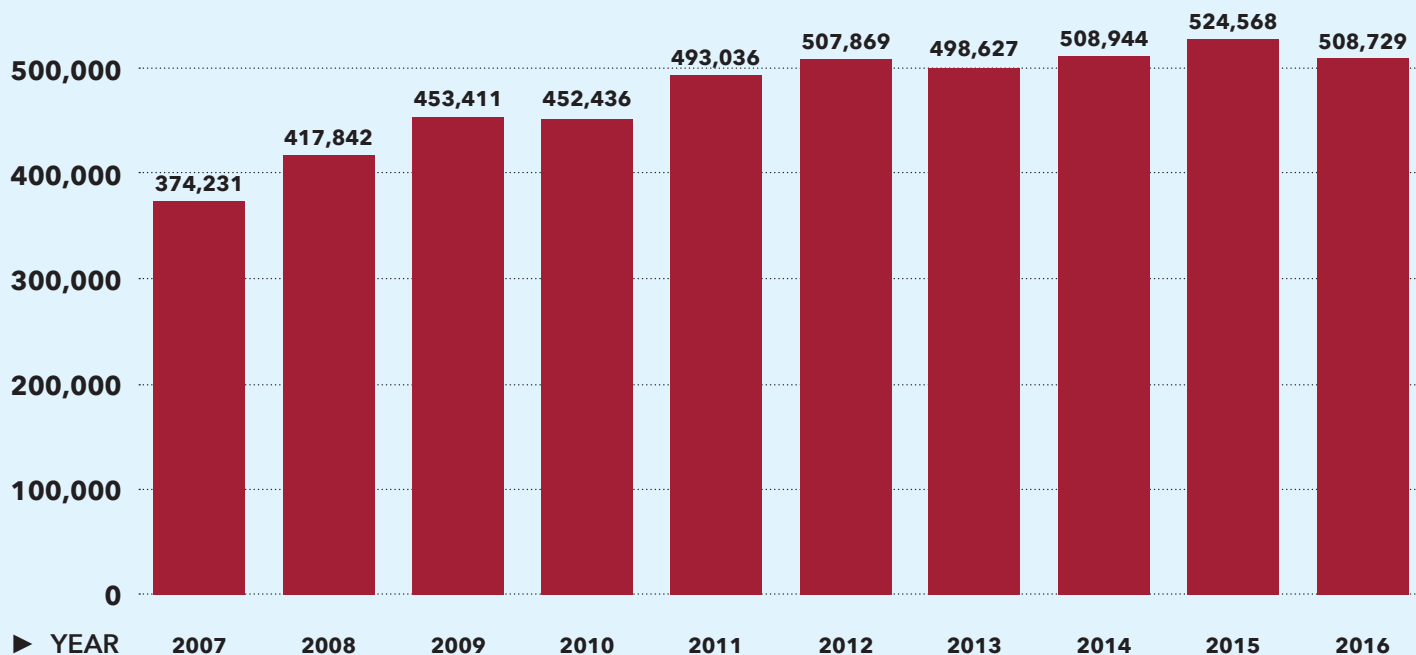

The number of inpatient admissions has declined by approximately 3% in the last 5 years. In this same time period, ambulatory surgeries increased by 3.7%. Patient days are increasing, even as admissions decline. Patient days in 2016 were approximately 17% greater than 5 years earlier
