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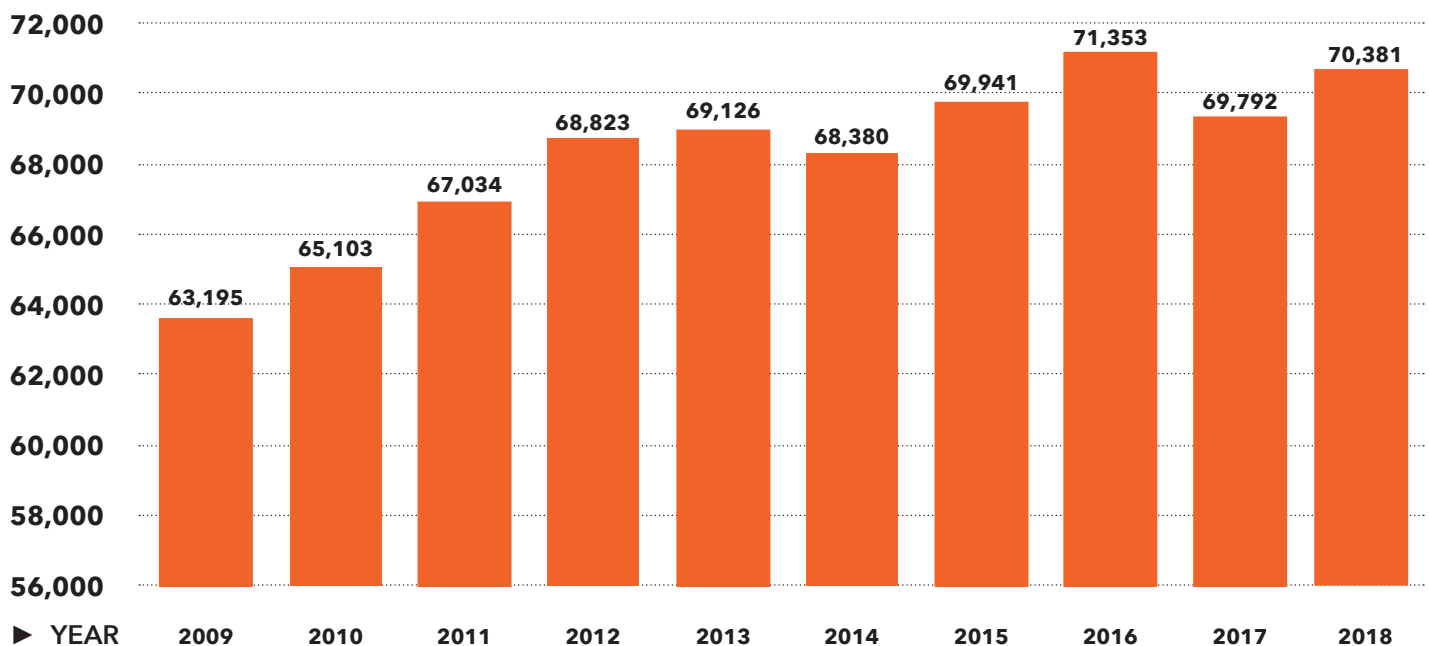

In 2018 there were 510,309 visits, representing an increase of 2.1% compared to 2017.

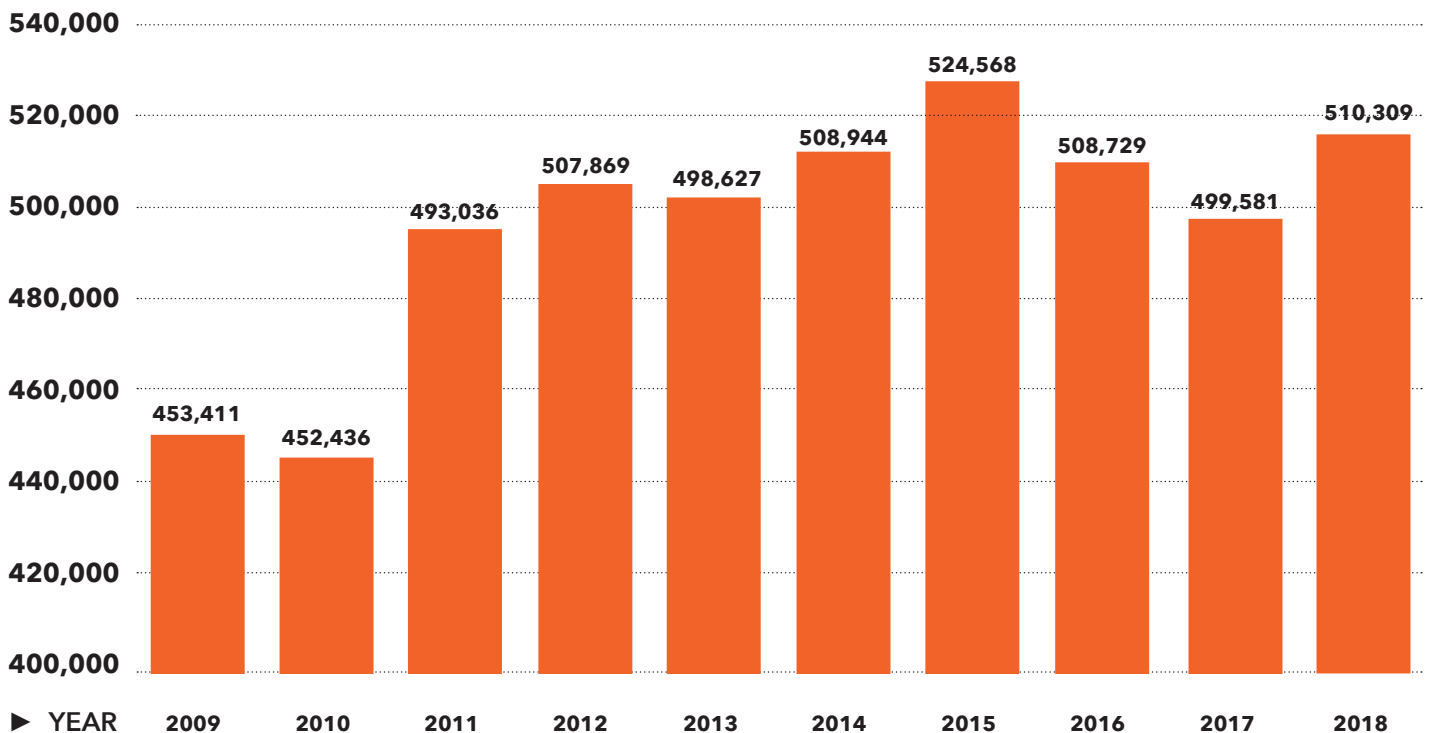

The number of inpatient admissions declined by approximately 2.3% between 2017 and 2018. This is the seventh year in a row that inpatient admissions have fallen. This trend is likely to continue as services shift to the outpatient setting rather than an inpatient one.

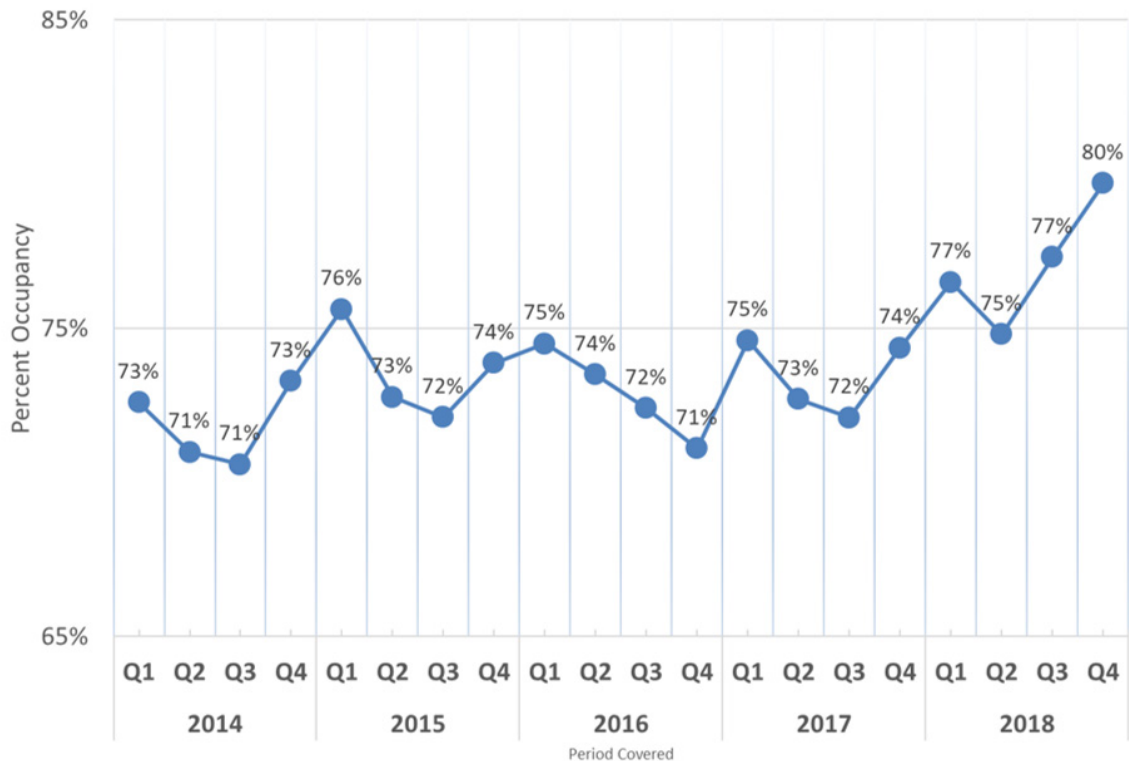
